2. **Born Masonry, Quote for South Park** - Richard Hostert explained areas that the pavers on the bridge, on the walk are on the way to the pergola, and under the pergola need leveled. Would need to pour a footing and concrete to the edges on the walkway. Will need to tuckpoint crack joints in the column cap, acid wash and clean tuckpointed areas. The council decided some of these areas are not an immediate concern but would like to get another quote for additional areas that need tuckpoint work.
