1. **Administer Oath of Office, Council Member-** Steve Wagle administered Oath of Office to Fred Gorges.
2. **Isaac Krumme, Tree Top Pond Quote** – Isaac Krumme talked to the council about the pond edge restoration. Tree Top will lower the pond level to expose footings during the repair. Stone will be replaced if needed. This project will take 3 to 5 days. There were concerns about the type of junipers they would plant. Isaac Krumme wants plantings that will keep people from getting close to the pond. **MOTION: R. Hostert motion to approve Tree Top quote for pond restoration and plantings at South Park in the amount of \$44,211.44. Seconded: F. Gorges; approved unanimously.**
3. **Evan Hartnett, Ideatek-** Kyle Beer requested to install fiber on the north side of Eastborough, this will also include the west side of Woodlawn. The connections will be ground level vaults. If they can start next week everything will be done and services will be available in about 10 weeks. They will use the same company they

used on the other side of Eastborough. **MOTION: (A. Standifer) I move to approve Ideatek to install fiber on the north side of Eastborough. Seconded: R. Hostert; approved unanimously.**

4. **#3 E Huntington Ave** – Adolfo Vazquez told the council he was asked to attend this meeting. He stated he is buying the property from the owner, Derek Blades. He advised that his 2 kids and parents live in the house with him. Jerry Bogle advised him to return next month with Derek Blades and to complete the home business application. Jerry Bogle told him that he would send a letter to Derek Blades and to him with the information needed for the meeting next month.

1. Provided monthly stats and Incident Daily Log report
2. Lexipol project has started, we are having weekly meetings. We will release the policies as they are added. The implementation is \$10,785.50 and the yearly subscription fee is \$5,768.10. This is more than I had requested last month. **MOTION: (A. Standifer) I move to approve the difference of the purchasing Lexipol for operating policies and procedures for \$6,553.60. Seconded: J. Cohlma; approved unanimously.**
3. New truck should be here in April. We plan on taking a cage and gun mount out of the 2023 truck and selling it for \$45,000. Has potential buyer
4. An officer hit another vehicle at Douglas and Woodlawn. It was taken to a body shop, and the repairs will be about \$2,200. The Highway Patrol did the investigation. We will not file a claim. There was no damage to our truck.
